

How to outline the Extended Response IB Psych Essay Questions

1. Argumentative Thesis. This is the most important part of your essay. If you do well here, everything else will naturally flow from it. As you formulate your argument in your head, make sure you can support your argument with three empirical studies.
2. Name each one of your three studies. Tell me specifically how each one supports your argument, and what kind of method was used. (experiment, case study, correlational study)

Do this for each one of the questions. You may, and you must, use some of the empirical studies in your response to several of the questions.

For Example;

1. Number and write out essay prompt

Thesis: Write out a good thesis that answers the question and is argumentative if appropriate.

- 1st Study. Name the study
 - Explain how this study supports your thesis. You may use a study for multiple learning outcomes, but how this study answers the outcome will be different for each prompt.
- 2nd Study. Repeat like you did for the first.
- 3rd Study. You need at least 3 studies per outcome.
